INVITATION TO BID

Date: October 16, 2020

Sealed Bids will be received by Garrison Diversion Conservancy District (Owner) at GDCD Office, 401 Hwy 281 NE, mailing address P. O. Box 140, Carrington, ND, 58421 until 2:00 p.m., local time, on Thursday, November 12, 2020 for **RRVWSP – MRIPS Wet Well & Site Development, Task Order 2520, Contract 1.**

At said place and time, and promptly thereafter, all Bids that have been duly received will be publicly opened and read aloud.

The proposed Work is generally described as follows:

Contract No. 1 – General Construction: Work generally consists of furnishing and installing a new concrete wet well; site and site access improvements and maintenance including 5,400 +/- l.f. of access road improvements with +/- 2,300 s.y. of articulating concrete surface, +/- 12,000 s.y. of Type A2 aggregate surface, and +/- 14,300 s.y. of geogrid reinforcement; grading, including +/- 4,950 c.y. cut and +/- 1,800 c.y. fill; +/- 6,900 c.y. topsoil removal and replacement; clearing and grubbing; drainage improvements, including 2 ea. 54-inch RCP flared end sections; signage, landscaping, temporary chain-link fence and gate, site restoration, +/- 41,500 s.y. seeding, and erosion control. Contractor shall also comply with all requirements in the Nationwide 12 Permit and the Road Maintenance Plans as attached to the Specifications. Note that tree removal for the intake site can only be done during the months of January and February.

Contract No. 1 – Alternate No. 1: Work generally consists of furnishing and installing a new temporary shaft cover for the concrete wet well as shown on the Drawings.

Printed Bidding Documents are available from GDCD by request for a NON-REFUNDABLE charge of One Hundred Dollars and No Cents (\$100.00) for each set of half size Plans and Specifications requested and One Hundred Twenty-Five Dollars and No Cents (\$125.00) for each set of full size Plans and Specifications requested. Charges listed above do not include shipping. Bidder can arrange for shipping or a quote for shipping charge will be provided.

Bidding Documents may also be examined at the offices of AE2S in Grand Forks, Bismarck, Fargo and Williston, ND; Moorhead and Maple Grove, MN, builders' exchanges in Grand Forks, Bismarck, Minot, and Fargo, ND, and in Minneapolis, MN. All bidding document interpretations and clarifications shall be directed to the Issuing Office.

Neither Owner nor Engineer has any responsibility for the accuracy, completeness or sufficiency of any bid documents obtained from any source other than the source indicated in these documents. Obtaining these documents from any other source(s) may result in obtaining incomplete and inaccurate information. Obtaining these documents from any source other than directly from the source listed herein may also result in failure to receive any addenda, corrections, or other revisions to these documents that may be issued.

Each bid must be accompanied by a separate envelope containing the contractor's license and bid security. The bid security must be in a sum equal to five percent (5%) of the full amount of the bid and must be in the form of a bidder's bond. A bidder's bond must be executed by the bidder as principal and by a surety, conditioned that if the principal's bid is accepted and the contract

awarded to the principal, the principal, within ten days after notice of the award, shall execute a contract in accordance with the terms of the bid and the bid bond and any condition of the governing body. A countersignature of a bid bond is not required under this section. If the Successful Bidder fails to execute and deliver the Agreement and to furnish the required contract security within the number of days set forth in the Bid Form, Owner may annul the Notice of Award and the Bid security of that Bidder will be forfeited.

The bidder shall be licensed for the full amount of the bid as required by section 43-07-12 of the North Dakota Century Code (NDCC).

Bids that do not fully comply with requirements of NDCC 48-01.2-05 are considered deficient and will be resealed and returned to the bidder immediately.

The Owner reserves the right to reject any and all bids and rebid the project until a satisfactory bid is received.

All Bids will be made on the basis of cash payment for such work and materials. All Bidders are invited to be present at the public opening of the Bids. The Owner reserves the right to hold the three (3) low Bids for a period of sixty (60) days after the date of the Bid opening to complete financial arrangements.

A virtual pre-bid conference will be held at 1:30 PM local time on Tuesday, November 3rd, 2020. Invitations to the virtual meeting will be via email in advance of the meeting. Attendance at the pre-bid conference is highly encouraged but is not mandatory.
